

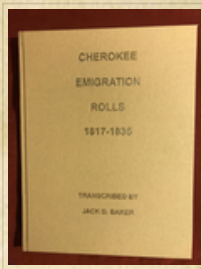

It includes name of head of households, how many males/females in household and current residence. Hardcover, 67 pages including index.

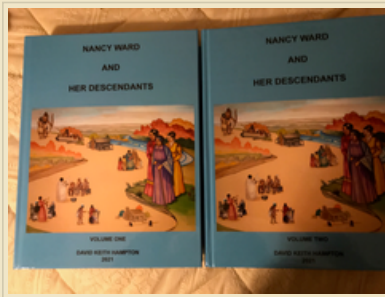

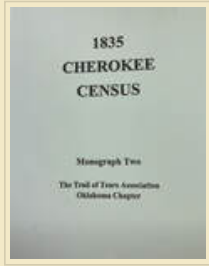

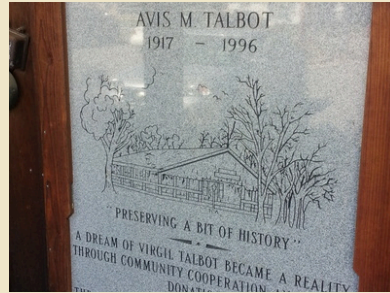
